

History of Rottnest Island

- More than 500,000 people visit Rottnest Island each year.
- The Island is 11 kilometres long, 4.5 kilometres at its widest point, and the land area measures 1,900 hectares.
- It is a 24km ride around the Island. Allow at least 2.5 hours for a leisurely cycle.
- First records of human occupation are from more than 6,500 years ago when the Island was still attached to the mainland. Since its initial European exploration from the 17th Century and its settlement in 1829, Rottnest Island has been through a number of stages of development and has been used for a variety of purposes.

Keep Safe this Weekend!
