- Disabled access toilets located at the Visitor Centre, Bedford Ave, Henderson Ave, Geordie Bay and Parker Point.
- Leave only footprints! Take your rubbish with you and keep Rottnest beautiful.
- Stay on the cycle and walk paths to protect flora.
- Rottnest Island is a high fire risk area. Fires are prohibited at all times.
- Beware of rocks, currents, waves, boats and wildlife when swimming.
- All commercial filming and drone usage must be approved by the Rottnest Island Authority. Visit rotnestisland.com/commercialfilming
- As tempting as it may be to "borrow" a bike, please be aware that this is considered stealing and a criminal offence.

On your walk from Thomson Bay to Oliver Hill, explore WWII infrastructure, beautiful beaches, shipwrecks, dense woodlands and lively lakes. Take a guided tour of the impressive guns and tunnels!

Discover the Salt Lakes (9.7km loop, 3-4hrs)

The salt lakes are easily accessible from the Settlement. The colours of the vegetation and flocks of migratory birds throughout the lakes system are a delight to behold.

Relax on Salmon Bay (10km one way, 3-4hrs)

Turquoise waters, bustling reefs, world class surf breaks, Osprey Eagles, horizontal trees and seasonal wild flowers. Cut inland at Fairbridge Bluff and take in the breathtaking 360° view at Wadjemup Lighthouse.

Take in the northern beaches (5.9km one way, 2-3hrs)

Beautiful long sandy beaches and calm swimming lagoons within the reef; there will be a favourite spot for everyone. Enjoy the excitement of rugged sections of trail, but be aware of seasonal access in high seas.

Ngank Wen Bidi

Explore West End (7.6km loop, 3-4hrs)

A marine wildlife haven! New Zealand fur seals can be seen from the viewing platform at Cathedral Rocks. The West End boardwalk is a great place to spot dolphins, and the seasonal migration of humpback whales!

Interpretive signage, sculptures and audio signs along the trail enhance the story of the rich cultural and environmental history of the Island.

Shuttle Bus

This regular Shuttle Service departs from the Main Bus Stop in Thomson Bay, travelling to the Georgie Bay General Store Bus Stop. It then returns to the Main Bus Stop before departing for the Airport (on request) and Kingstown Barracks.

Last departure from Main Bus Stop to Georgie Bay: 6:00pm (Sun-Thurs) 7:00pm & 8:00pm (Fri, Sat & School Hols)
Last departure from Main Bus Stop to Kingstown Barracks: 6:10pm (Sun-Thurs) 7:10pm & 8:10pm (Fri, Sat & School Hols)

Purchase your tickets online, at the Rottnest Island Visitors Centre or from the Main Bus Stop kiosk. **Cost: \$3 per person per day (Flat Fee) and \$5 per person per week (7 days). Children under 5 years of age travel free. Please note if you have an Island Explorer ticket it is valid for use on the Shuttle and you are not required to purchase a shuttle ticket.**

Tickets must be purchased and presented to the driver at all **outbound journeys** from the Main Bus Stop only. Passengers that are returning or joining the service at Kingstown, Airport or Georgie Bay are not required to present a ticket to board.
